SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

6-304.

- (a) An applicant who otherwise qualifies for a license is entitled to be examined as provided in this section.
- (b) (1) The Board shall give examinations to applicants at least once a year, at the times and places that the Board determines.
- (2) The Board may give reexaminations to applicants who fail all or part of the examination at the times and places that the Board determines.
- (c) The Board shall notify each qualified applicant of the time and place of examination.
- (d) (1) Except as otherwise provided under this title, the Board shall determine the subjects, scope, form, and passing score for examinations given under this subtitle.
 - (2) Each examination shall include:
 - (i) A section on the theory of electrology; and
 - (ii) A section on the clinical practice of electrology.
- (e) (1) An applicant may retake an examination or a failed section of an examination after paying [to the Board] a reexamination fee [of \$50] SET BY THE BOARD.
- (2) An applicant who fails two reexaminations may retake the examination only if the applicant:
 - (i) Retakes the entire examination;
 - (ii) Pays the full examination fee; and
 - (iii) Completes an education program that the Board requires.
