 - [3.] C. Occupation and occupation of spouse;
 - [4.] D. Length of residence within the county; AND
 - [5.] E. Prior jury service;
- [6.] 2. Whether [he] THE POTENTIAL JUROR should be excused from jury service [,] BECAUSE THE INDIVIDUAL has any physical or mental infirmity impairing [his]. THE INDIVIDUAL'S capacity to serve as a juror;
