(Senate Bill 208)

AN ACT concerning

Joint Budget and Audit Committee – Evaluation of Federal Aid

FOR the purpose of specifying that reports evaluating federal aid shall be sent by each unit of State government to the ~~budget committees of the General Assembly~~ Budget and Taxation Committee of the Maryland Senate and the Appropriations Committee of the Maryland House of Delegates, rather than to the Joint Budget and Audit Committee; and altering the powers and duties of the Joint Committee with regard to the evaluation of federal aid.
