SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Family Law

2-404.

- (a) (1) The fee for a license is \$10.
- (2) The clerk shall:
 - (i) retain \$5 of the fee; and
 - (ii) pay \$5 of the fee into the general fund of the county.
- (b) (1) Except as provided in subsections (c), (f), and (g) of this section, any county or group of 2 or more counties may set an additional fee of up to \$25 for each license.
 - (2) The proceeds shall be used to fund domestic violence programs.
- (c) In Anne Arundel County:
 - (1) the County Council may set by [resolution] ORDINANCE an additional fee [as authorized in this section] OF UP TO \$45 for each license;
 - (2) the clerk shall pay the proceeds from the additional fee to the general fund of the county each month; and
