

(b) (1) Except as provided in subsections (f) and (g) of this section, any county or group of 2 or more counties may set an additional fee of up to \$25 for each license.

(2) The proceeds shall be used to fund domestic violence programs.

(i) In Cecil County:

(1) the Board of County Commissioners shall set an additional fee of **[\$10]** \$20 for each license;

(2) the clerk shall pay the proceeds from the additional fee to the County Treasurer each month;

(3) the proceeds in addition to designated federal funds and county funds shall be given to Cecil County Department of Social Services Advisory Board to be used to fund battered spouse shelters and domestic violence programs; and

(4) the Cecil County Department of Social Services Advisory Board shall prepare and make available to the Board of County Commissioners an annual report on or before December 1 of each year of the disposition of fees collected under this subsection during the previous fiscal year.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993.

CHAPTER 112

(Senate Bill 301)

AN ACT concerning

Tort and Insurance Reform Oversight Committee – Repeal
