FOR the purpose of requiring, under certain circumstances, a school bus that is used to transport students to or from school in Baltimore County to pick up or discharge each student in a manner that does not require the student to walk across a public road or highway when entering or exiting the bus requiring the establishment in Baltimore County of a Pupil Transportation Safety Advisory Committee; specifying the duties of the Committee; providing for the appointment of members; and generally relating to pupil transportation safety in Baltimore County.
