- (2) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a manufacturer's rated capacity of 3/4 ton or less; or
 - (3) A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.
- (b) The Administration may issue and continue a special registration number under this section if:
- (1) The owner of the motor vehicle submits, with the original application, proof satisfactory to the Administration that the owner of the vehicle is a member of a nonprofit organization and complies with the regulations adopted by the Administration under subsection (c) of this section; and
- (2) At least 25 owners of vehicles in a class apply to the Administration for the assignment of special registration numbers, and at least 25 special registration numbers are issued initially.
- (c) The Administration shall adopt regulations not inconsistent with the Maryland Vehicle Law to govern the issuance of special registration plates to members of nonprofit organizations.
- (d) (1) In addition to the annual registration fee otherwise required under this title, an owner of a vehicle assigned a special registration under this section shall pay a fee set by the Administrator DETERMINED BY THE ADMINISTRATION each time new registration plates are issued to the vehicle.

(2) The fee:

- (i) May not exceed the amount required to enable the Administration to recover its costs under this section;
- (ii) Shall be retained by the Administration for the purpose of recovering its cost under this section; and
- (iii) May not be credited to the Gasoline and Motor Vehicle Revenue Account for distribution under § 8-403 or § 8-404 of the Transportation Article.
- (3) Notwithstanding paragraphs (1) and (2) of this subsection, an owner of a vehicle assigned a special registration plate that displays an emblem or logo as authorized under this section shall pay an annual fee of \$25 in addition to the annual registration fee required under this title.
- (e) The additional fee to the annual registration fee required by <u>UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF</u> this section is not required for special registration of a vehicle that is exempt under § 13–903 of this title, or a vehicle with a special registration plate recognizing:
 - (1) The Maryland National Guard; or
- (2) A volunteer fire department, volunteer rescue squad, or volunteer ambulance company in this State.
