## 1993 LAWS OF MARYLAND

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Education

21-305.

- {(a)}The State Board of Education and the State Workers' Compensation Commission shall administer jointly the program established in {this section and} {3 21-306 of this subtitle.
  - [(b) (1) There is an Injured Workers Rehabilitation Committee.
- (2) The Committee consists of six members, four of whom are appointed by the Governor. Of the appointed members:
  - (i) One shall be an employer;
  - (ii) One shall be an employee;
  - (iii) One shall be a representative of a casualty insurance company; and
    - (iv) One shall be a registered physician.
- (3) The Chairman of the State Workers' Compensation Commission and the Director of the Division of Rehabilitation Services are ex officio members.
- (4) Each appointed member serves for a term of 6 years, and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. These terms are staggered as required by the terms of the members serving on July 1, 1978.
- (5) A member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term serves only for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
  - (6) Each member of the Committee:
    - (i) Serves without compensation; and
- (ii) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses from the State Workers' Compensation Commission in accordance with the Standard State Travel Regulations.
- (c) (1) The Governor shall designate a member of the Committee as its chairman.
- (2) The Committee may determine the time and place of its meetings and may adopt rules for the conduct of its meetings. However, the Committee shall meet at least once every 3 months.]
