(c) (2) If an employer compels an employee to work on the day of rest that the employee chooses under subsection [(c)] (B) of this section, the employee is entitled to bring an action against the employer to recover 3 times the regular rate of pay of the employee for each hour the employee works on that day.

(a) (2) The Workers' Compensation Commission shall reimburse the General Fund of the State for the cost of administering this title from money that the Commission receives under [§ 9-315(b)(1)] § 9-316 of this article.

(a) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, employment is covered employment if the employment is:

(1) performed for a charitable, educational, religious, or other organization;  
and

(2) excluded from the definition of "employment" in the Federal Unemployment Tax Act SOLELY by § 3306(c)(8) of the Act.
