*SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, for fiscal year 1994, notwithstanding any other provision of law, the moneys generated from the additional \$5 court costs imposed under Section 20 of Chapter \_\_\_\_\_ (H.B. 419) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1993 shall be transferred to the Judicial Assistance Fund to fund the temporary assignment of judges under § 1-302 of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article.*

**CHAPTER 225**

**(Senate Bill 270)**

AN ACT concerning

**Vehicle Laws – Farm Vehicles – Definitions and Uses**

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of the terms “farm vehicle”, “farm truck”, “farm truck tractor”, and “farm trailer or semitrailer” to include certain vehicles used by a farmer to haul farm products for another farmer for hire; and generally relating to the definitions and uses of certain farm vehicles.
