(4) A county or municipal corporation may exercise the powers granted under this section notwithstanding any limitations or other provisions to the contrary of [Articles 23A, 25A, or 25B] ARTICLE 23A, ARTICLE 25A, OR ARTICLE 25B of the Code or of any charter or local law.
