SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Estates and Trusts

2-108.

- (y) (1) Except in Montgomery, Washington, Frederick, Carroll, Talbot, Caroline, Cecil, Kent, Queen Anne's, Baltimore, Garrett, and Harford Counties and Baltimore City, and except as provided in [paragraph] PARAGRAPHS (3) AND (4) of this subsection, a county shall pay a pension, in the same manner as salaries are paid during active service, to each judge of the Orphans' Court who:
  - (i) Has terminated active service;
  - (ii) Has reached 60 years of age; and
  - (iii) Has completed at least two terms of office.
  - (2) The salary or pension shall be the greater of:
    - (i) \$1,200 annually; or
- (ii) An annual amount calculated at the rate of 4 percent of the last annual amount of compensation multiplied by the number of years of partial years of service, not exceeding 12 years.
