- (3) An Orphans' Court judge in Somerset [, Wicomico,] and Worcester Counties is eligible for a pension under this subsection only if he is in office on or before July 1, 1979.
- (4) IN WICOMICO COUNTY, AN ORPHANS' COURT JUDGE WHO HAS COMPLETED AT LEAST 12 YEARS IN OFFICE IS ELIGIBLE FOR A PENSION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.
- [(4)](5) The pension or salary may be suspended during any month the judge is a full-time employee of any county or of this State.
- [(5)](6) Notwithstanding any provision of this section an Orphans' Court judge may not receive a pension under this section if he is receiving any other State pension.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993.

(Senate Bill 396)

AN ACT concerning

Pensions - Eligible Rollover Distributions
