(A) ~~[A:] THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION ARE APPLICABLE:~~

~~(1) AT any time after the termination of a marriage by divorce, annulment, or death [ , an ]; OR~~

~~(2) NOTWITHSTANDING THE MARITAL STATUS OF A PARENT OR CUSTODIAN OF A GRANDCHILD, IF:~~

~~(H) A GRANDPARENT HAS ESTABLISHED OR ATTEMPTED TO ESTABLISH A SUBSTANTIAL PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH A NATURAL OR ADOPTED GRANDCHILD; AND~~

~~(H) THE PARENT OR CUSTODIAN OF THE CHILD HAS DENIED THE GRANDPARENT REASONABLE OPPORTUNITY FOR VISITATION WITH THE CHILD.~~

(B) AN equity court may:

(1) consider a petition for reasonable visitation OF A GRANDCHILD by a grandparent [of a natural or adopted child of the parties whose marriage has been terminated]; and

(2) ~~if the court finds it to be in the best interests of the child,~~ grant visitation rights to the grandparent~~;~~

~~(H) AFTER CONSIDERATION OF ALL RELEVANT FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES;~~

~~(H) IF THE COURT FINDS VISITATION TO BE IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE CHILD; AND~~

~~(H) SUBJECT TO ANY CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS THE COURT MAY CONSIDER APPROPRIATE.~~

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993.
