violating certain local rules or regulations not more than \$500; establishing the fine to be in addition to any other penalties; requiring the Board to consider certain eriteria in setting the amount of a fine imposed alcoholic beverages inspectors to issue civil citations for certain alcoholic beverages offenses relating to minors; requiring alcoholic beverages inspectors in Anne Arundel County to successfully complete a certain training program before issuing civil citations; prohibiting alcoholic beverages inspectors in Anne Arundel County from carrying firearms in the performance of their duties; and generally relating to violations of local the issuance of civil citations in Anne Arundel County for certain alcoholic beverage rules by offenses relating to minors.
