(C) (1) THE COUNCIL SHALL ACTIVELY ADVOCATE AND PROMOTE THE INTERESTS OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPPORTUNITIES IN STATE HOSPITAL CENTERS. THE COUNCIL SHALL SEEK TO ENSURE THAT A QUALITY EDUCATION AND EQUAL EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY ARE AVAILABLE TO ALL RESIDENTS IN STATE HOSPITAL CENTERS.

(2) THE COUNCIL SHALL ON A REGULAR BASIS REVIEW THE PROGRAM OF INSTRUCTION USED IN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AT STATE HOSPITAL CENTERS TO ENSURE THAT THE UNIQUE EDUCATIONAL NEEDS OF THOSE POPULATIONS ARE BEING SATISFACTORILY MET.

(3) THE COUNCIL SHALL INCLUDE IN ITS REVIEW:

(I) CURRICULUM GUIDES;

(II) COURSES OF STUDY;

(III) RESOURCE MATERIALS;

(IV) TEXTBOOKS;

(V) SUPPLEMENTARY READERS;

(VI) MATERIALS OF INSTRUCTION;

(VII) VISUAL AND AUDITORY AIDS;

(VIII) SUPPLIES;

(IX) TEACHER PERFORMANCE; AND

(X) OTHER TEACHING AIDS.

(4) BASED ON THEIR REVIEW, THE COUNCIL SHALL RECOMMEND AND ADVOCATE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AT STATE HOSPITAL CENTERS.

(a) (1) Funds for the operation of the educational program in State hospital centers shall be provided in the budget of the [State Department of Education] DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.
