

[(3)](2) The Administration may determine the compensation of [employees]:

(I) EMPLOYEES if the compensation is determined pursuant to Subtitle 6 of this title [The Administration may determine the compensation of executive];

(II) EXECUTIVE management positions, as recommended by the Secretary [of Transportation] and approved by the Governor, subject to approval in the budget [The Administration may determine the compensation of management]; AND

(III) MANAGEMENT positions, subject to approval by the Secretary and the Governor and the availability of funds in the budget.

(a) To the extent practicable, the transit plans prepared by the Administration shall:

(1) Implement the general development plan of the Baltimore [Regional] METROPOLITAN Council [of Governments]; and

(2) In order to provide for a balanced transportation system and for the coordination of transit planning and general planning, be prepared in consultation with the Baltimore [Regional] METROPOLITAN Council [of Governments].

(a) On issuance in this State of an original or subsequent certificate of title for a vehicle, the vehicle is exempt from the excise tax imposed by this part, if it is:

(19) A salvage vehicle acquired by a licensed dealer that has been restored by the licensed dealer and that has been inspected under [§ 13-506 (b)(1)(i)] § 13-507(A)(2)(II) of this title; or
