## 1993 LAWS OF MARYLAND

- 1. Monday through Saturday from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day; and
- 2. Sunday from 12:30 p.m. to 10 p.m., provided that the sale of alcoholic beverages is only permitted for consumption by patrons who are seated on the premises; and
  - (ii) Off-sale:
    - 1. Monday through Saturday from 6 a.m. to 12 midnight; and
    - 2. Sunday no off-sale privilege.
  - (7) FOR A CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE:
- (I) MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY FROM 10 A.M. TO 2 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY; AND
  - (II) SUNDAY FROM 12:30 P.M. TO 10 P.M.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act-is-an-emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

## **CHAPTER 281**

(House Bill 111)

## Toxics in Packaging - Civil Penalties

FOR the purpose of specifying that persons who violate certain provisions relating to toxics in packaging are liable for certain civil penalties; requiring the State to recover certain civil penalties in civil actions; and generally relating to certain civil penalties for certain violations related to toxics in packaging.
