

- 1. Monday through Saturday from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day; and
- 2. Sunday from 12:30 p.m. to 10 p.m., provided that the sale of alcoholic beverages is only permitted for consumption by patrons who are seated on the premises; and

(ii) Off-sale:

- 1. Monday through Saturday from 6 a.m. to 12 midnight; and
- 2. Sunday - no off-sale privilege.

(7) FOR A CLASS GC (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE:

(I) MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY FROM 10 A.M. TO 2 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY; AND

(II) SUNDAY FROM 12:30 P.M. TO 10 P.M.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act-is-an-emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

CHAPTER 281
(House Bill 111)

AN ACT concerning

Toxics in Packaging - Civil Penalties

FOR the purpose of specifying that persons who violate certain provisions relating to toxics in packaging are liable for certain civil penalties; requiring the State to recover certain civil penalties in civil actions; and generally relating to certain civil penalties for certain violations related to toxics in packaging.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
