SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

14-401.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Camper" means any child under 18 years of age who is attending a youth camp.
- (c) "Occasional use" means periodic involvement in a program where there is no expectation of regular attendance.
- (d) (C) "Council" means the Youth Camp Safety Advisory Council.
- (e) (D) "Day camp" means a youth camp that:
 - (1) Is operated for all or part of the day but less than 24 hours a day;
 - (2) Is conducted for at least 7 days during a 3-week period; and
 - (3) Provides 3 or more recreational activities or any 1 specialized activity including:
 - (i) Aquatic programs;
 - (ii) Horseback riding;
 - (iii) Firearms control;
 - (iv) Riflery;
