- (c) [(1)]"Light wine" means any naturally fermented wine containing not in excess of 14 percent of alcohol by volume.
- [(2) In Kent County, light wine means any fermented beverage not in excess of 22 percent of alcohol by volume.
- (3) In Montgomery County light wine means any naturally fermented or fortified wine not in excess of 22 percent of alcohol by volume.
- (4) In St. Mary's County light wine means any fermented beverage not in excess of 22 percent of alcohol by volume.
- (5) In Somerset County light wine means any fermented beverage not in excess of 22 percent of alcohol by volume.
- (6) In Wicomico County light wine means any fermented beverage not in excess of 22 percent of alcohol by volume.
- (7) In Worcester County light wine means any fermented beverage not in excess of 22 percent of alcohol by volume.
- (8) In Queen Anne's County, light wine means any fermented beverages not in excess of 22 percent of alcohol by volume.]
