(House Bill 306)

AN ACT concerning

Lead-Based Paint Occupation Accreditation of Lead Paint Abatement Services

FOR the purpose of requiring that persons who ~~engage in lead occupations to provide lead paint abatement services~~ be accredited by the Department of the Environment; defining certain terms; ~~authorizing~~ requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations; providing that the Department shall set reasonable fees to cover certain costs; establishing a Lead Accreditation Fund with certain funding sources; providing for the enforcement of this ~~subtitle~~ Act; ~~declaring the intention of the General Assembly~~; and generally relating to ~~lead based paint occupation accreditation of lead paint abatement services.~~
