- (g) (1) A Class 6 pub-brewery license shall be issued:
 - (i) By the State Comptroller; and
- (ii) Only to a holder of a Class B beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) license that is issued for use on the premises of a restaurant [located in Anne Arundel County, the City of Annapolis, Baltimore City, Frederick County, Harford County, Washington County, Worcester County, or the City of Gaithersburg in Montgomery County].
 - (III) ONLY IN THE FOLLOWING JURISDICTIONS:
 - 1. ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY;
 - 2. ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY CITY OF ANNAPOLIS:
 - 3. BALTIMORE CITY;
 - 4. HARFORD COUNTY:
 - 5. MONTGOMERY COUNTY CITY OF GAITHERSBURG; AND
 - 6. WORCESTER COUNTY.

- (a) A Class A beer license shall be issued by the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which the place of business is located. [and shall authorize the] THE holder [thereof to] OF THE LICENSE MAY keep for sale and sell beer at retail[,] in any quantity to any consumers at the place [therein] described IN THE LICENSE.[, and to] THE HOLDER SHALL deliver the [same] BEER in a sealed package or container, which package or container [shall] MAY not be opened nor its contents consumed on the premises where sold. The annual fee for the license [shall be \$25 and] shall be [payable] PAID to the clerk before any license [be] IS issued, for distribution as [hereinafter] provided.
 - (b) (1) In Allegany County the annual fee [for such a license] is \$75.
- (2) The package or container [shall] MAY not be opened nor its contents consumed on any premises in which the licensee [shall have] HAS any direct or indirect interest.
