SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

19–202.

- (a) (1) The Board consists of [6] 7 members.
 - (2) Of the [6] 7 Board members:
- (i) 5 shall be licensed social workers of whom 1 is a licensed social work associate; and
 - (ii) [1] 2 shall be a consumer member.
- (3) The Governor shall appoint one licensed social worker member from a list of qualified individuals submitted to the Governor by the Maryland Chapter of the National Association of Social Workers, Inc.
- (4) The Governor shall appoint one licensed social worker member from a list of qualified individuals submitted to the Governor by the Metropolitan Washington Chapter of the National Association of Social Workers, Inc.
- (5) The Governor shall appoint the other [two] 3 licensed social worker members.
- (6) The Governor shall appoint the consumer member with the advice of the Secretary and the advice and consent of the Senate.
- (B) (1) AT A MEETING HELD BY THE MARYLAND CHAPTER OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SOCIAL WORKERS, INC. CALLED TO CHOOSE NOMINEES FOR A SOCIAL WORKER VACANCY ON THE BOARD, A MAJORITY OF THE SOCIAL WORKERS PRESENT AT THE MEETING SHALL CHOOSE THE LIST OF NAMES OF SOCIAL WORKER NOMINEES TO THE BOARD FOR SUBMISSION TO THE GOVERNOR.
- (2) AT A MEETING HELD BY THE METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON CHAPTER OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SOCIAL WORKERS, INC. CALLED TO CHOOSE NOMINEES FOR A SOCIAL WORKER VACANCY ON THE BOARD, A MAJORITY OF THE SOCIAL WORKERS PRESENT AT THE MEETING SHALL CHOOSE THE LIST OF NAMES OF SOCIAL WORKER NOMINEES TO THE BOARD FOR SUBMISSION TO THE GOVERNOR.
