

CHAPTER 334

(House Bill 871)

AN ACT concerning

**Baltimore County – Alcoholic Beverages
(Class B (TTC) License – Extension)**

FOR the purpose of extending the abrogation date for Class B (TTC) alcoholic beverages licenses in Baltimore County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
Chapter 452 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1991
Section 2

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 452 of the Acts of 1991

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991. The provisions of this Act permitting the transfer of any class beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) retail licenses into the "Towson Town Center" in Baltimore County and the conversion of those licenses into Class B (TTC) licenses shall remain effective for a period of [2] 4 years and, at the end of [June 30, 1993] SEPTEMBER 30, 1995, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, those provisions shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1993.
