SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Tax - Property

8–114.

- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "HOOPHOUSES" MEAN TEMPORARY STRUCTURES PLACED ON LAND THAT ARE MADE OF PLASTIC ATTACHED TO HOOP-LIKE SUPPORTS AND USED FOR AGRICULTURAL PURPOSES.
 - (B) A HOOPHOUSE SHALL BE VALUED AS PERSONAL PROPERTY UNLESS:
- (1) THE SUPPORTS FOR THE HOOPHOUSE ARE AFFIXED TO THE LAND WITH CEMENT OR SIMILAR MATERIAL; OR
- (2) THE HOOPHOUSE IS PLACED ON A CEMENT OR OTHER FOUNDATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30, 1994. Approved May 11, 1993.
