CHAPTER 350

(House Bill 1044)

AN ACT concerning

Health Insurance - Long-Term Care Insurance

FOR the purpose of extending the express rulemaking authority of the Insurance Commissioner regarding long term care insurance to include termination of insurance and requirements for replacement; altering the applicability of a preexisting condition limitation; requiring that certain additional information be included in the outline of coverage for a long term care policy; imposing certain requirements concerning content and delivery of policy summaries when a life insurance policy provides long-term care benefits; requiring certain monthly reports to be delivered to policyholders during payout of certain long-term care benefits; and generally relating to long-term care insurance and benefits.
