SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 48A - Insurance Code

(f) "Preexisting condition" means a condition for which medical advice or treatment was recommended by, or received from, a provider of health care services within [9 months] 6 MONTHS prior to the effective date of coverage of the insured or certificate holder.

644.

The Commissioner may adopt regulations regarding long term care insurance with respect to:

- (1) The form and content of disclosures;
- (2) The terms of renewals;
- (3) Initial and subsequent conditions of eligibility;
- (4) Nonduplication of coverage provisions:
- (5) Preexisting conditions;
- (6) Renewability of coverage;
- (7) Continuation and conversion;
- (8) Probationary periods, limitation of coverage provisions, and recurrent conditions;
 - (9) Coverage of dependents;
 - (10) Loss ratio standards; [and]
 - (11) TERMINATION OF INSURANCE;
 - (12) REQUIREMENTS FOR REPLACEMENT; AND

[(11)] (13) Any matter the Commissioner determines is in the best interest of the public.
