(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:

- (1) ALL EMPLOYEES, INCLUDING CLASSIFIED, UNCLASSIFIED, FULL-TIME, PART-TIME PERMANENT, TEMPORARY, AND CONTRACTUAL EMPLOYEES, OF ALL UNITS IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING ANY UNIT WITH AN INDEPENDENT PERSONNEL SYSTEM; AND
- (2) ALL CLASSIFIED SERVICE EMPLOYEES OF THE DISTRICT OF MARYLAND.
- (a) (B) (1) An employee IN THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION is entitled to extra pay, known as shift differential pay, if the employee:
 - (i) is employed in a position designated for this purpose; and
- (ii) works on a full-time shift of at least 8 hours that starts on or after 2:00 p.m. and on or before 1:00 a.m.
- (2) A State-employed fire fighter is entitled to shift differential pay for qualifying hours if the fire fighter works on a shift of at least 8 hours, regardless of the time that the shift starts.
- [(b)](C) (1) The Secretary shall adopt regulations for the payment of shift differential pay.
- (2) The regulations adopted under this section shall provide for fairness and equity among all employees in consideration of:
 - (i) the hours worked;
 - (ii) conditions and places of employment;
 - (iii) prevailing practices in the locality; and
- (iv) other factors that the Secretary considers relevant under the circumstances.

- (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, in § 6-309 of this subtitle, or otherwise by law, this subtitle applies to:
- (1) all employees, including classified, unclassified, full-time, part-time, permanent, temporary, and contractual employees, of all units in the executive [, judicial, and legislative branches] BRANCH of State government, including any unit with an independent personnel system; AND
- (2) ALL CLASSIFIED SERVICE EMPLOYEES OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF MARYLAND.
