(House Bill 1164)

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County – Casino Nights – Regulation

PG 302-93

FOR the purpose of ~~prohibiting a casino night from being held in Prince George's County unless certain licenses and permits are obtained; establishing certain license and permit fees; requiring certain agencies in Prince George's County to perform certain functions; requiring a public hearing before issuance or renewal of a license; requiring dealers and other casino night workers to have certain permits; establishing requirements concerning licenses and permits; requiring a license holder to meet certain conditions; requiring that a player at a casino night be a certain age; providing for the construction of this Act; establishing certain penalties; establishing certain procedures relating to licensure and appeals; defining certain terms; providing that the Sheriff of Prince George's County may perform the administration, enforcement, and related investigation of casino nights upon authorization of the county governing body; establishing a certain penalty; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to the regulation of casino night gaming events~~ nights in Prince George's County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 – Crimes and Punishments

258B.

(a) Any group of citizens of Prince George's County, or any company, association or body corporate, bona fide organized [or hereafter bona fide organized] within [said county] PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY for the promotion of the purposes of a volunteer fire department, or of any charitable, benevolent, patriotic, fraternal, educational, religious or civil object [or objects], and not organized for the private profit or gain of
