- (B) (1) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES the owner or operator of any steam, DIESEL, or electric railway or club, parlor, buffet, observation, sleeping or dining cars [upon] ON the lines of any steam, DIESEL, or electric railway in this State [,] to keep for sale and to sell beer and light wines [upon] IN any of [such] THOSE cars, for consumption [upon such] IN THE cars [, and every such].
  - (2) THE license [shall be good] IS VALID throughout the State.
- (C) The annual LICENSE fee [for such license shall be sixty dollars (\$60.00)] IS \$60. [, and]
- (D) THE FEE shall be [payable] PAID to the Comptroller for the use of the State before [any such] THE license is issued.

This section is revised for clarity of language and structure. In addition, "diesel" is included to recognize a third form of energy that powers railroad engines.

- (a) (1) A Class A beer, wine and liquor license shall be issued by the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which the place of business is located. [, and shall authorize] THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES the holder to keep for sale and to sell all alcoholic beverages at retail, in any quantity, at the place [therein] described IN THE LICENSE. [, and to] THE LICENSEE SHALL deliver the [same] ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES in a sealed package or container [which] AND THE package or container may not be opened nor its contents consumed on the premises where sold. The annual LICENSE fee [for this license is \$500, except as otherwise provided in this section, and in all cases the fee] shall be [payable] PAID to the clerk before [any such] THE license is issued, for distribution as [hereinafter] provided.
- [(b)](2) A license may not be issued for any drugstore unless the applicant [has]:
- (I) HAS been doing business at the location applied for, for at least one year prior to the date of the application for the license, or [unless the applicant is]
- (II) IS the assignee of a business established for that length of time at the location applied for, or [unless the applicant has]
- (III) HAS been actually engaged in the retail drug business for a period of not less than three years.
  - [(c)](B) (1) In Allegany County the annual license fee is \$600. [, and the]
- (2) THE package or container may not be opened nor its contents consumed on any premises in which the licensee has any direct or indirect interest.
  - [(d)](C) In Anne Arundel County the annual license fee is \$600.
  - [(f)] (D) In Baltimore City the annual license fee is \$650.
