- (ii) 'Each of these members serves for a term of 5 years and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. These terms are staggered as required by the terms of the members serving on July 1, 1978.
- (iii) Each of these members may be reappointed but may not serve more than two full 5-year terms.
- (3) The following officials shall serve ex officio and each may designate someone to serve in his place:
  - (i) The State Superintendent of Schools;
  - (ii) The Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene;
  - [(iii) The Secretary of the Department of Juvenile Services Agency;]
  - [(iv)] (III) The Deputy Secretary for Public Health Services;
- [(v)] (IV) The Director of the Developmental Disabilities Administration;
- [(vi)] (V) The Superintendent of Public Instruction of Baltimore City; and
- [(vii)](VI) Two county superintendents of schools from counties where a State hospital center [or a juvenile residential institution of the Department of Juvenile Services Agency] is located, who shall be selected by the State Superintendent of Schools.
  - (c) Each member of the Council:
    - (1) Serves without compensation; and
- (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses in accordance with the Standard State Travel Regulations.
  - (d) (1) The State Superintendent shall serve as chairman of the Council.
- (2) The Council shall determine the time and place of its meetings and may adopt rules for the conduct of its meetings.
- (3) The State Department of Education shall provide technical assistance and support:
  - (i) To the Council; and
- (ii) To the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene in the development and operation of educational programs in State hospital centers [and juvenile residential institutions].
