

(b) An associate solicitor may not solicit money from the public for a professional solicitor unless the professional solicitor [is registered] HAS APPLIED TO REGISTER with the Secretary of State and can show evidence of the [registration] APPLICATION.

6-603.

A professional solicitor may not make an agreement with a charitable organization to raise money on its behalf unless the charitable organization [is registered] HAS APPLIED TO REGISTER with the Secretary of State.

6-617.

~~(A) A professional solicitor or associate solicitor may not solicit charitable contributions for or in the name of a charitable organization unless the professional solicitor or associate solicitor:~~

~~(1) has written authorization that contains:~~

~~(i) the consent of 2 officers of the charitable organization;~~

~~(ii) the signature of the professional solicitor; and~~

~~(iii) an express statement of the term of the authorization;~~

~~(2) submits a copy of the authorization to the Secretary of State; and~~

~~(3) on request, shows a copy of the authorization and personal identification to a person who is solicited.~~

~~(B) A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION, PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR, ASSOCIATE SOLICITOR, OR FUND-RAISING COUNSEL MAY NOT INTENTIONALLY SOLICIT A PERSON WHO HAS INFORMED IT THAT THE PERSON DOES NOT WANT TO BE SOLICITED.~~

~~AN INDIVIDUAL CONVICTED OF A THEFT RELATED FELONY MAY NOT FOR 3 YEARS, OCCUPY A POSITION WITH A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION OR PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR INVOLVING ITS MANAGEMENT OR DIRECTION, OR THE CUSTODY OF OR AUTHORITY TO SPEND CONTRIBUTIONS.~~

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993.
