This subtitle may be cited as the "Maryland Youth Camp Act".

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That each youth camp directed or operated by a bona fide religious organization under § 14-403(a)(4) of the Health – General Article as enacted by this Act shall be inspected by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene or the Department's designee prior to commencement of operations each year, and may be inspected at any time upon complaint to the Department. Such inspection findings shall be reported to the Department, and the Department may take appropriate enforcement actions, and may report any violation of federal, State, or local law to the appropriate agency for appropriate action, including investigation or prosecution.

SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1993.

CHAPTER 389

(House Bill 1511)

AN ACT concerning

Health Insurance - Breast Implants

FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain health insurers from denying or canceling, or imposing certain conditions on renewal of a policy of health insurance solely because the insured has had a breast implantation; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to health insurance coverage for breast implants.

A POLICY OF A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN:
