**CHAPTER 409**

**(Senate Bill 46)**

AN ACT concerning

**Uniform System for Accessible Parking for Individuals With Disabilities**

FOR the purpose of establishing a uniform system in this State for providing accessible parking, under certain circumstances, to individuals with disabilities; establishing a process for the issuance of a parking permit for a person with a disability, and for a temporary parking permit for a person with a temporary disability; conforming certain provisions of law to certain provisions of federal law; requiring the Maryland Port Commission to adopt regulations to provide for a uniform system for accessible parking for individuals with disabilities in conformity with certain federal laws; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to adopt regulations to provide for a uniform system for accessible parking for individuals with disabilities in conformity with certain federal laws; specifying certain parking lot requirements to accommodate individuals with disabilities; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to a system for parking for individuals with disabilities.
