- subsection (a)(2) of this section expires at the discretion of the Administration but may not exceed 90 days from the date of issue.
- (ii) The permit may be renewed on application with proof of the handicap or disability and payment of the prescribed fee.
- (3) A permit issued under this section shall have its expiration date indicated on its face in large letters or numbers.]
- (e) (1) A [disabled person's] parking permit FOR A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY shall be issued:
- (i) Except as provided in item (ii) of this paragraph, in the form of a REMOVABLE WINDSHIELD placard capable of being hung from the inside rearriew mirror and of a size and design as determined by the Administration; or
- (ii). For a vehicle not equipped with an inside rearview mirror or in which the inside rearview mirror is not visible from the rear of the vehicle, in the form of a windshield placard of a size and design as determined by the Administration.
  - [(2) The placard shall contain the following information:
    - (i) The permit number;
    - (ii) The name and signature of the issuing authority;
- (iii) The designation "Disabled Person's Parking Permit" displayed within the international wheelchair symbol;
  - (iv) The date of expiration; and
  - (v) Any other pertinent information the Administration requires.]
- [(3)](2) A person to whom a [disabled person's] parking permit FOR A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY is issued shall display the placard described in this section in:
  - (i) A Class A (passenger) vehicle or a Class M (multipurpose) vehicle;
- (ii) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a 3/4 ton or less manufacturer's rated capacity and specially equipped for the transportation of or operation by [a handicapped] AN individual WITH A DISABILITY; or
- (iii) A Class H, I, or J vehicle that is specially equipped for the transportation of [handicapped] individuals WITH DISABILITIES and is used exclusively for the transportation of [handicapped or disabled] individuals WITH DISABILITIES.
- (f) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, when displayed by the person to whom a REMOVABLE WINDSHIELD placard is issued, the REMOVABLE WINDSHIELD placard shall be hung from the inside rearview mirror when the vehicle is parked.
