- (ii) If the Administration determines that eligibility requirements are not being met, the Administration may revoke the [disabled person's] parking permit FOR A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY.
- (i) Any person who violates the provisions—of—this—section is guilty of a misdemeanor, in accordance with the terms of § 27 101 of this article.
- (J) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADMINISTER THE REMOVABLE WINDSHIELD PLACARD PROGRAM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

- (A) A PERSON MAY APPLY TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOR A TEMPORARY REMOVABLE WINDSHIELD PLACARD PARKING PERMIT ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE ADMINISTRATION IF:
- (1) THE PERSON HAS A DISABILITY, AS CERTIFIED BY A LICENSED PHYSICIAN; AND
- (2) THE ADMINISTRATION DETERMINES THAT THE DISABILITY IS NOT PERMANENT BUT WOULD SUBSTANTIALLY IMPAIR THE APPLICANT'S MOBILITY OR LIMIT OR IMPAIR THE APPLICANT'S ABILITY TO WALK FOR AT LEAST 3 WEEKS, AND IS SO SEVERE THAT THE APPLICANT WOULD ENDURE A HARDSHIP OR BE SUBJECT TO RISK OF INJURY IF THE TEMPORARY PARKING PERMIT WERE DENIED.
- (B) AN APPLICATION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY:
- (1) PROOF SATISFACTORY TO THE ADMINISTRATION THAT THE APPLICANT IS A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, AND
- (2) THE CERTIFICATION OF A LICENSED PHYSICIAN THAT THE APPLICANT IS DISABLED, INCLUDING AN ESTIMATE OF THE LENGTH OF TIME THE DISABILITY WILL CONTINUE.
- (C) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ESTABLISH AND CHARGE A FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THE TEMPORARY REMOVABLE WINDSHIELD PLACARD PARKING PERMIT FOR A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY AND FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A DUPLICATE PLACARD.
- (D) A TEMPORARY REMOVABLE-WINDSHIELD PLACARD PARKING PERMIT FOR A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE VALID FOR A PERIOD OF TIME THE PHYSICIAN HAS DETERMINED THAT THE APPLICANT IS LIKELY TO HAVE THE DISABILITY, NOT TO EXCEED 6 MONTHS.
- (E) (1) A TEMPORARY PARKING PERMIT FOR A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY SHALL BE ISSUED IN THE FORM OF A TEMPORARY REMOVABLE WINDSHIELD PLACARD FOR A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY SHALL BE ISSUED IN THE FORM, SIZE, AND DESIGN DETERMINED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
