

(ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.

(b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1993.

CHAPTER 419

(Senate Bill 238)

AN ACT concerning

Health Maintenance Organizations – Pharmaceutical Services

FOR the purpose of requiring health maintenance organizations and their agents that propose to offer pharmaceutical services or propose to change the manner of payment for pharmaceutical services that are currently provided by certain providers to provide ~~a certain written notice, certain offer, and certain opportunity to all pharmacies in the area served by the health maintenance organization~~ certain notification to a certain association under certain circumstances; prohibiting a certain fee; allowing the Maryland Pharmacists Association to distribute certain information; providing for a certain exemption; and generally relating to health maintenance organizations and pharmaceutical services.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

19-713.3.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION" OR "HMO" INCLUDES ANY AGENT OF A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION.
