

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all personal property, records, and fixtures held by the State Council on Vocational-Technical Education on September 30, 1993 shall be and hereby are transferred to the Work Force Investment Board.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993.

CHAPTER 464

(Senate Bill 627)

AN ACT concerning

Code Home Rule Counties – Water and Sewer Services

FOR the purpose of authorizing the county commissioners of a code home rule county to establish and assign certain duties to a department of public facilities and services; requiring the county commissioners to abolish certain entities if responsibility for water and sewerage service is assigned to the department; specifying certain requirements concerning the abolishment of certain entities; authorizing the county commissioners to request certain information; providing that, if the county commissioners abolish certain entities, the county commissioners exercise certain powers; authorizing the county commissioners of a code home rule county, subject to a certain condition, to enter into an agreement under the terms of which a municipal corporation or local community will assume responsibility for water or sewerage services; requiring the agreement to meet certain requirements; protecting certain employees' benefits; requiring that certain revenues remain dedicated for certain purposes; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the authority of the county commissioners of a code home rule county to establish a department of public facilities and services, abolish a water or sewer authority or sanitary district or commission, transfer to a municipal corporation certain responsibilities and otherwise provide certain water and sewerage services.
