# Article - Family Law

5-324.

The court may not enter a final [adoption] decree=FOR-ADOPTION OR FOR GUARDIANSHIP OF AN INDIVIDUAL until at least 15 days after the birth of the individual [to be adopted].

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1993.

## State Board of Foresters

FOR the purpose of altering certain responsibilities of the State Board of Foresters, including requiring the State Board of Foresters to adopt regulations establishing a code of ethics and implementing a continuing education requirement; making the completion of certain continuing education a condition for certain license renewals in and after a certain license term; adding certain actions to the grounds for certain disciplinary actions by the Board; altering certain penalties; continuing the Board in accordance with the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act by extending to a certain date the termination provision-relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the Board and the regulation of foresters; and generally relating to the State Board of Foresters.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# Article - Business Occupations and Professions

7-206.

- (a) In addition to any powers set forth elsewhere, the Board may adopt:
  - (1) any bylaw for the conduct of the proceedings of the Board; and
  - (2) any regulation to carry out this title.
