- (b) In addition to any duties set forth elsewhere, the Board:
 - (1) shall administer this title;
 - (2) shall adopt a seal;
 - (3) shall keep a record of its proceedings; and
- (4) on or before September 30 of each year, shall submit to the Governor a report on the transactions of the Board during the previous fiscal year.
 - (c) The Board shall keep a record that, for each application for a license, shows:
 - (1) the applicant's:
 - (i) name;
 - (ii) age;
 - (iii) residence;
 - (iv) place of business; and
 - (v) educational and other qualifications;
 - (2) the date of the application;
 - (3) whether the applicant was required to take an examination;
 - (4) the action of the Board on the application;
 - (5) the reason for the action; and
 - (6) any other information the Board considers necessary.
 - (d) The Board shall:
- (1) keep a list of all licensed foresters that shows the name and place of business of each licensee;
 - (2) provide a copy of the list:
 - (i) on request, to any member of the public; and
 - (ii) every 2 years, on or before March 31, to:
 - 1. each licensee; and
 - 2. the Secretary of State.
- (E) (1) WITH THE ADVICE OF THE ESTABLISHED FORESTRY ASSOCIATIONS, THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT, BY REGULATION, A CODE OF ETHICS FOR PRACTICING FORESTRY.
 - (2) THE BOARD SHALL DISTRIBUTE A COPY OF THE CODE OF ETHICS:
 - (I) TO EACH APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE; AND
