~~(2) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL TAKE CHARGE OF, PROSECUTE, AND DEFEND ON BEHALF OF THE STATE EVERY CASE ARISING UNDER THIS SECTION, INCLUDING THE RECOVERY OF PENALTIES.~~

(j) Fines collected for violations of this section shall be disbursed to the county or city where the violation occurred to be used to defray the expense of establishment and maintenance of receptacles and posting of signs as provided in subsection (i) of this section AND FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSES RELATING TO THE REMOVAL OR CONTROL OF LITTER.
