

fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

(6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bond, the Board of Directors of the Baltimore City Life Museums, Inc. shall grant and convey to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of its interest:

- (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- and
- (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.

(b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1993.

CHAPTER 476

(Senate Bill 835)

AN ACT concerning

**Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages
(Caterer's License)**

FOR the purpose of creating a special off-sale alcoholic beverages privilege for caterers who hold a certain alcoholic beverages license in Baltimore County; providing for the license; and generally relating to an addition to certain Baltimore County alcoholic beverages licenses.
