[(3)](IV) [In Baltimore City the] THE minimum criteria for the issuance of a Class B-BWL (H-M) license are as follows:

[(i)] 1. The hotel or motel shall contain no less than 100 rooms for the accommodation of the public[.];

[(ii)]2. The hotel or motel shall contain a dining room with facilities for preparing and serving regular meals for at least 125 persons at one seating[.]; AND

[(iii)] 3. The capital investment in the hotel or motel facility may not be less than \$500,000.
