~~(i)~~ 1. The hotel or motel shall contain no less than 100 rooms for the accommodation of the public~~];~~

~~(ii)~~ 2. The hotel or motel shall contain a dining room with facilities for preparing and serving regular meals for at least 125 persons at one seating~~];~~ AND

~~(iii)~~ 3. The capital investment in the hotel or motel facility may not be less than \$500,000.

~~(iv)~~ (V) A Class B-BWL (H-M) license may not be required of any restaurant that is not located in a hotel or motel or of any catering establishment.

3. "BOARD" MEANS THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS.

(III) ~~In Baltimore City,~~ for any stadium, convention hall, or other arena, the Board of License Commissioners is authorized to approve the issuance of a special Class B beer, wine and liquor license, to be known as an "arena license", for the sale of] A LICENSEE MAY SELL beer, wine and liquor by the drink and by the bottle within the arena, from one or more outlets, for consumption on the licensed premises.
