AN ACT concerning

Retirement and Pension Systems – State Maryland Aviation Administration – Fire Rescue Service

FOR the purpose of requiring certain full-time employees of the State Maryland Aviation Administration Fire Rescue Service to become members of the Pension System for Employees of the State of Maryland; altering a certain definition to include certain employees in the employees retirement system; and limiting membership in the Baltimore City fire and police employees retirement system to those full-time State Maryland Aviation Administration fire rescue employees hired on or before a certain date.
