- (A) THERE IS A COMMISSION ON COMPLEMENTARY MEDICAL METHODS WHICH SHALL DEFINE WHICH HEALTH CARE METHODS ARE COMPLEMENTARY MEDICAL METHODS AND STUDY HOW TO ALLOW THE USE OF COMPLEMENTARY MEDICAL METHODS BY MARYLAND PHYSICIANS WITH PATIENTS WHO WISH TO BE TREATED THROUGH COMPLEMENTARY METHODS FOR THEIR MEDICAL CONDITIONS.
