SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION

6-201.

- (A) (1) THERE IS A PUBLIC BODY POLITIC AND CORPORATE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND KNOWN AS THE WASHINGTON COUNTY SANITARY DISTRICT.
- (2) THE DISTRICT MAY EXERCISE THE POWERS AND DUTIES CONFERRED BY THIS TITLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE COUNTY ESTABLISHING THE DISTRICT.
 - (B) BY EITHER ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION, THE COUNTY MAY:
- (1) Change the name of the district or of the commission or both;
 - (2) AMEND THE BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT; AND
- (3) CHANGE, ADD TO, OR DIMINISH THE POWERS AND PURPOSES OF THE DISTRICT AND THE COMMISSION, PROVIDED THAT THE SAME ARE CONSISTENT WITH OTHER PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE AND THE CODE.
- (C) THE COUNTY SHALL ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A SUITABLE AND PROPERLY INDEXED FILE FOR THE RECORDING OF DOCUMENTS UNDER THIS TITLE. 6–202.
- (A) (i) THE COMMISSION SHALL EXERCISE THE POWERS OF THE DISTRICT CONFERRED BY THIS TITLE.
- (2) THE COMMISSION SHALL CONSIST OF FIVE MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY.
- (3) OF THE FIVE MEMBERS, THERE SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF EACH OF THE FIVE REPRESENTATION AREAS OF THE DISTRICT.
- (4) (I) EACH MEMBER SERVES FOR A TERM OF FIVE YEARS BEGINNING JANUARY 1 AFTER THE APPOINTMENT OF THE MEMBER AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (II) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS SHALL BE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION SERVING ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT.
 - (III) A MEMBER MAY SERVE FOR MORE THAN ONE TERM.
- (5) THE COUNTY MAY REMOVE A MEMBER FOR CONTINUED NEGLECT OF DUTY, INCOMPETENCE, OR UNPROFESSIONAL OR UNETHICAL CONDUCT.
- (6) IF A VACANCY OCCURS BY DEATH, RESIGNATION, OR REMOVAL BY THE COUNTY, THE COUNTY SHALL PROMPTLY APPOINT A SUCCESSOR TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM.
