Transportation Revenue Bonds; providing that County Transportation Revenue Bonds issued under this Act are not debt of the State or of the Department of Transportation, but are obligations of the participating counties; authorizing the counties of the State to enter into certain agreements to provide for the repayment of bonds issued under this Act; authorizing the Comptroller and the Treasurer to withhold certain County revenues under certain circumstances; providing for an effective date; and generally relating to the Department of Transportation's issuance of County Transportation Revenue Bonds.
