- (2) The Board may allow the applicant to apply up to 1,500 hours of accredited, approved school study toward the experience requirement of paragraph I(1)(ii) I(1)(1) of this subsection.
 - (d) An applicant for a master plumber license:
- (1) shall have completed at least 3,750 hours of training in providing plumbing services as a journey plumber licensed in this State or another state and under the direction and control of a licensed master plumber; [and]
- (2) (i) if an applicant resides in this State, shall have a journey plumber license for at least 2 years; or
- (ii) shall have been licensed in another state as a journey plumber after:
- 1. completing at least 7,500 hours of training in providing plumbing services under the direction and control of a licensed master plumber; and
- 2. passing a written examination that is equivalent to the examination for a journey plumber license given in this State; AND
- (3) SHALL HAVE COMPLETED AT LEAST 32 HOURS OF TRAINING IN THE TESTING OF BACKFLOW PREVENTION DEVICES, IN A MANNER APPROVED BY THE BOARD.
 - (E) AN APPLICANT FOR A CERTIFICATE SHALL:
- (1) HOLD A JOURNEY PLUMBER LICENSE OR A MASTER PLUMBER LICENSE: AND
- (2) SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE AT LEAST 32 HOURS OF TRAINING, INCLUDING CLASSROOM AND PRACTICAL WORK, AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD.
- {(e)}(F) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, an applicant for a master plumber license [or], a journey plumber license, OR A CERTIFICATE shall pass an examination given by the Board under this subtitle.

An applicant-for a license OR CERTIFICATE-shall:

- (1) submit to the Board an application on the form that the Board provides; and
 - (2) pay to the Board an application fee of:
 - (i) \$20-for a master plumber license;
 - (ii) \$10 for a journey plumber license; or
 - (iii) \$15 for an apprentice plumber-license; OR
 - (IV) AN AMOUNT SET BY THE BOARD FOR A CERTIFICATE.
